

ACADEMY—[a-kad-e-my] a place for specialized training.

ADENA—[a-de-na] one of the fleets passenger ships.

AERIAN MERCHANT CODE—[air-e-n] an obsolete code developed by Aerian's yahrens ago for use by their transport ships.

AERINA—[air-e-na] a planet in the third quadrant.

AGRO—[a-gro] the production of consumables

AGRONLONS—[ag-ron-lons] the measurement of the strength of a transmitting frequency.

AIR DOME—an area built for the landing and departing of aircraft and spacecraft.

AMBROSA—[am-bro-sa] a rare drink distilled and purified in low gravity for at least a yahren.

ANTI-BURN BAFFLES—[an-ti burn baf-les] a protective plating housing pulse generators on fighter craft.

AQUARIUS—[ah-kwar-ee-us] a ship and a planet.

ARCTA—[arc-ta] an asteroid in the second quadrant.

ARMISTICE[ar-mi-stis] a pause in a war brought about by agreement between the warring sides.

ARMORMENT—[ar-mor-ment] a collection of arms and ammunition.

ASENCION TUBE—[a-sen-shun] a cage or platform in a building or a ship which can be raised or lowered for carrying persons or goods from one level to another.

ASTERAL WINDS—[as-ter-al] winds produced by gravities interacting between close orbit planets.

ASTRALON—[as-tra-lon] a high velocity particle found in deep space ranging in size from microscopic diameters up to several metrons.

ATTACK COMPUTER—[a-tak kom-put-er] a computer in a fighter directly linked to the crafts scanner. See scanner.

ATTILLA—[a-til-la] a planet in the Omega system now in the hands of the Cylons.

AUTOMATIC DETONATOR—[or-to-mat-ik det-o-nat-or] a self-destruct device.

BALCON—[bal-kon] a star in an uncharted system known to be the closest Cylon penetration to earth.

BARATON—[bar-a-ton] a childs spinning toy.

BASESTAR—[bas-star]cylon. a slow moving, not easily maneuverable deep spacecraft. They are believed to carry over 300 fighters, and have two long range mega-pulsars and over 100 laser turrets.

BATTLESTAR—a deep spacecraft assembled in planetary orbit with a maxium before fueling range of 500 light-yahrens. It is strictly an outer space vehicle. See military section.

BIO—PULSE LINES—a system for monitoring fighter pilots bodily functions during flight.

BIO-ROBOTICS—the study and application of creating robots to be like humans in every detail.

BLOOD TRAIL—a hunt to revenge the Borellian code, where they hunt down and kill a prey. See Borellians.

BOOKS OF THE LORDS OF KOBOL—a semi-mystic chronicle containing the writings of the Lords of Kobol during the Age of the Philosophers during the second millenium.

BOOK OF STRATEGY—fighter pilots manual.

BOOK OF THE WORD—the oldest and most sacred of the books of the Lords of Kobol. It contains lofty moral precepts still followed today, with its central theme being the constant struggle between good and evil.

BORALLUS—[bor-al-as] a rich agro world first settled by humans after the rediscovery of space travel. Now in the hands of the Cylons.

BORAYS—[bor-as] Intelligent, pre-technological natives of the planet Equellus. They live in herds on the planet Sectara under the leadership of one dominant Boray.

BORELLIANS—[bor-elle-ns] a fierce nomadic people called Nomen, who for thousands of yahrens inhabited a desert area of one of the colonial worlds, whose cruel tribal customs have survived into the interstellar age. They have no respect for society, its laws, or its principles.

BORILLO—[bor-ril-lo] a freighter.

BORATON—[bor-a-ton] a fire fighting material.

BURITICIANS—[bur-it-i-shuns] the hereditary nobility of the twelve colonies, originally appointed by the Lords of Kobol, to rule over each colony. Over the millenia, many of the original families died out, and new buritian families were founded by great military and political leaders in each colony.

BUZZER—a slang term given to a variety of crude, homemade, intoxicating beverages.

CANARIUS—[ka-nar-ius] a commercial shuttle.

CARILLON—[kar-i-lon] a small planet, very rich in tylium. First discovered by humans in 6392. Destroyed in 6550.

CARBON SYNTHETIC—[kar-bon sin-thet-ic] a material used in place of metal in lasers and other equipment.

CELESTIAL CHAMBER—[se-les-chal cham-ber] a transparent dome on many spacecraft used for observation and navigation.

CELESTRA—[se-les-tra] an old battleship now used as the fleets electronics ship.

CENTAURIE—[sen-tor-e] 100 centons.

CENTON—[sen-ton] 100 microns.

CENTURIONS—[sen-tu-ri-uns] see military section.

CHANCERY—a place where all types of wagering games are played.

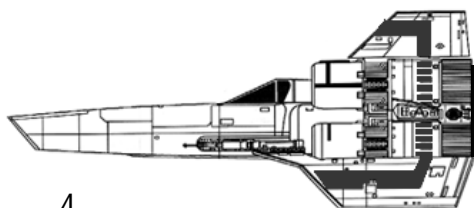
CHECK—[chek] oregg, coined or stamped, used by the Orions as a medium of exchange.
