

ATOMIC MOTORS

The atomic motors are located in the engine room behind a six inch thick lead door. An inspection hatch in the floor, at the base of the door, will allow the pilot to check the performance of the engines without entering the engine room itself. The engine room is a high radiation area and should never be entered while the atomic motors are in operation.

To service the atomic engines an elevator located outside near Tripod No. 3 will lower the engine for quick repair or removal. Most engine repairs will require a normal gravity for proper adjustment.

The engines will run on deutronium fuel pellets. This radio active ore is so powerful that just six canisters can propel the ship to the stars.
