



A REPORT TO THE PRESIDENT

This document has been prepared by the Alpha Control Research Staff as a comprehensive explanation and evaluation of the Alpha Control program, its goals, and accomplishments. This document also seeks to explain the catastrophic loss of the Jupiter 2 spacecraft and its crew. We believe that the conclusions reached herein reflect the integrity of the Alpha Control organization, and its commitment towards fulfilling its intended goal of successfully landing a colonization ship on a planet outside our solar system.

This report was, in part, made possible by the log books from the Jupiter 2, left by Prof. Robinson on Fuel Barge/Weather Station F-12, under the command of Siras T. Fogey. These logs were picked up on March 11, 2000, when a relief crew reached the outer space lighthouse, and were returned back to earth about a year later. The logs, containing a comprehensive account of the Robinson family's first three years in deep space, were invaluable in preparing this report and in verifying the performance of the ship, equipment, and crew. It also confirmed the role of Dr. Zachary Smith in sabotaging the mission.

This final version of our report is hereby submitted for your approval. We believe it will prove satisfactory in helping your determination as to whether or not the Alpha Control program should continue.
